Improved the configuration process for the plug-in. The first time that you access the plug-in the selection tree, the Exchange Server Configuration dialog box is displayed automatically.	DNPE-661
Added an additional option, Do Not overwrite existing Files , to Restore and Recovery Options , which lets you choose whether to overwrite existing files in the Target Directory.	DNPE-664

Added support for Exchange Server 2016 CU8 and CU9 on Windows Server 2012 R2 and Windows 2016.	DNPE-674, DNPE-702
Added support for hardware-based, integrated VSS snapshots for the Dell Compellent product line when used with a standalone Exchange Server deployment.	DNPE-676
NOTE: For DAG deployments, hardware snapshots are not currently supported by the plug-in. If you are running a DAG environment, ensure that the software-based Microsoft VSS provider is in place and has preference over any vendor's hardware-based VSS provider. Also be aware that NetVault Backup-managed persistent snapshots are not supported in DAG deployments.	
Added support for Exchange Server 2013 CU19 and CU20 on Windows Server 2012 and 2012 R2.	DNPE-703

Upgrade and compatibility

Plug-in *for Exchange* 12.0 requires NetVault Backup 11.4.5 or later. For complete supported-platform information, see the *Quest NetVault Backup Compatibility Guide*.

Product licensing

To obtain the license key for your NetVault Backup Server environment, determine the NetVault Machine ID of your main NetVault Backup Server. Also identify the machine IDs of any clients running application plug-ins, such as Oracle, MySQL, PostgreSQL, SQL Server, and Exchange.

You can use the NetVault Configuration Wizard to install the product license keys. Alternatively, you can install the license keys from the Manage Clients page.

Obtaining a machine ID

- 1 Start the NetVault Backup WebUI.
- 2 In the Navigation pane, click **Manage Clients**.
- 3 In the **NetVault Backup Clients** list, select the applicable machine, and click **Manage**.
- 4 On the **View Client** page, note the machine ID exactly as it is displayed in the **Client Summary** table.

Installing a license key using the configuration wizard

- 1 In the **Navigation** pane, click **Guided Configuration**.
- 2 On the **NetVault Configuration Wizard** page, click **Install Licenses**.
- 3 In the **NetVault Backup Clients** list, select the applicable machine, and click **Next**.
- 4 In the **Enter the license key string** box, type or copy and paste the license key, and click **Apply**.
After the key is applied successfully, a message is displayed.

Installing a license key from the Manage Clients page

- 1 In the **Navigation** pane, click **Manage Clients**.
- 2 In the **NetVault Backup Clients** list, select the applicable machine, and click **Manage**.
- 3 On the **View Client** page, click **Install License**.
- 4 In the **Install License** dialog box, type or copy and paste the license key, and click **Apply**.
After the key is applied successfully, a message is displayed.
- 5 To dismiss the dialog box, click **Close**.
