Container management enhancements

To ease the management of containers, you can now set keywords on them, locate them in the Search Folders based on those keywords, and edit their properties once they have been found.

NOTE: This option is only available for SQL configuration stores.

Microsoft Azure GCC High support

Microsoft Azure GCC High is supported for email for notifications and approvals.

Improved security for Office 365 and Exchange Online

To improve security, GPOADmin now requires certificate authentication for Office 365 and Exchange Online. All existing connections that use Office 365 and Exchange Online for notifications must be updated with certificates that have been uploaded to Azure Active Directory App certificates & secrets.

Additional Microsoft Intune support

GPOADmin now includes support for Microsoft Intune's compliance policies.

The following workflow actions are supported:

- · Register/ Unregister
- Check In/ Check Out/ Undo Check Out
- · Migration Actions
- · Modify Security
- · Apply Workflow / Approval Workflow order
- · Failed Deployment
- Get/ Import
- · Roll Back/ Restore/ Delete
- Incorporate Live
- Deploy
- Check Compliance

The following PowerShell commands have also been added to help manage Intune support:

- Add-ConfigurationProfileAssignments has been renamed to Add-IntuneAssignments and functions for both configuration profiles and compliance policies.
- Clear-ConfigurationProfileAssignments has been renamed to Clear-IntuneAssignments and functions for both configuration profiles and compliance policies.
- Remove-ConfigurationProfileAssignments has been renamed to Remove-IntuneAssignments and functions for both configuration profiles and compliance policies.
- Get-ConfigurationProfileAssignments has been renamed to Get-IntuneAssignments and functions for both configuration profiles and compliance policies.
- · Get-Unregistered and Get-SettingsReport now support compliance policies.

Ability to validate synchronization results

You can easily see the synchronization results and view which GPOs have been successfully (or unsuccessfully) synchronized on the selected target.

Validation rule enhancements for protected settings

Ability to include the processing of added items when the validation rule is set to Value.

If you select to base it on value, you can choose the items to include based on the following:

- Items that exist in the policy that do not exist in the Protected Settings Policy are ignored.
- Items that exist under the User Rights Assignment in the policy that do not exist in the Protected Settings Policy are included in the validation process and are flagged as Invalid.
- tems that exist in the policy that do not exist in the Protected Settings Policy are included in the validation process and are flagged as Invalid

- Windows 11
- Microsoft Edge WebView2 Evergreen Bootstrapper 97.0.1072.69 for editing Intune Configuration Profiles

Miscellaneous updates

- Ability to configure SQL replication from within the client.
- · Ability to include the contents of the Settings and Difference reports in the body of the notification email.
- · New Modify Link Properties right.
- Ability to restrict which global catalogs are used within the forest to search for the GPOADmin server during connection.
- Ability to schedule the generation of RSoP reports to validate whether the desired Group Policy settings have been applied.
- Ability to use Microsoft Graph APIs when using Office 365 for notifications.
- Selected items are automatically refreshed on right-click.
- Default SPN set on install now uses server and port format.
