About ApexSQL Search

ApexSQL Search is a SQL Server Management Studio and Visual Studio add-in, for SQL object and data text search, managing extend properties, rename objects without breaking dependencies.

New Features

This version of ApexSQL Search introduces the following new features, enhancements or deprecations:

Fixes:

- 162811: A selected database from Object Explorer is not automatically targeted within Object search controls when a search is initiated from the toolbar
- 165044: Application default shortcuts under the Options dialog cannot be modified and saved

- 165047: SQL Server Management Studio stops working when the ellipsis button is clicked from the result grid under the Column value of the Text search pane and the user is connected to a remote server using Azure Active Directory - Integrated authentication
- 165725: "Unsaved documents cannot be cut or copied to the clipboard from the miscellaneous files project. You must save the unsaved document(s) before cutting or copying them." error message appears when either Ctrl+C or Ctrl+X command is used from the Search text box of the Text search panel
- 165732: The Text search feature does not find any results when the search string has either leading or trailing whitespace characters in the search phrase
- 165734: Initiated text search is not cancelled when the Text search pane is closed
- 172022: Text search feature does not work when invoked against an Azure SQL database and the user does not have access to the master database
- 186418: Unable to determine which connection is being used to perform either an object or data search from the drop-down list of distinct server names under the Database section
- 194476: Objects search and Text search features do not work when clicked from the toolbar if no server is previously selected from either SQL Server Object Explorer or Server Explorer in Visual Studio
- 199489: "Insufficient permissions to access master database" info message is shown when either Object search or Text search is initiated and the user is connected to a remote server using Azure Active Directory - Integrated authentication
- 200245: Text search feature does not return any results if the search scope has a table with a column of either money or smallmoney data types

- Object search does not return any results of functions and schema search which had a similar name
- The Navigate to object explorer freezes SSMS/VS and does not find the Temporal table (History) in Object Explorer

- Object reference not set to an instance of an object error message appears when use the Options command from add-in main menu in Visual Studio 2019
- The context menu has a 3 seconds delay until is displayed when right-click is used on a trigger in Object Explorer

- Object and Text search tabs are displayed empty within Visual Studio 2019 if the Optimize rendering for screens with different pixels densities option is enabled in the General node of the Options dialog

- Settings set in the custom Values tab does not apply to settings under the Select objects to search pane of the Text search dialog
- Table filters under the Select object to search pane of the Text search dialog do not work properly
- The Check for updates on startup option is not saved when unchecked and the host application is restarted
- The Object search dialog has multiple issues on high DPI and 4K resolution
