

NetVault Backup 12 Implementation and Administration Module One -Introduction to NetVault Backup

Description:

This is the first module in a four part NetVault Backup 12 implementation and administration course series designed to instruct students on the essentials of deploying, configuring, and operating NetVault Backup in their environment. In this module, you will be introduced to NetVault Backup's installation and configuration, major architectural components, the new web-based user interface and the essential set of tasks needed to get your backup domain operational.

After completing the entire four part series, you will have received detailed instructions on NetVault Backup implementation and administration, including daily operation, basic troubleshooting techniques, and best practices.

- Real-time monitoring functions provided through the WebUI.
- Detailed steps required to add clients, client groups and storage device targets.
